MENOMINEE TRIBAL COURT: JURY TRIALS

Jury trials were temporarily suspended effective on March 23, 2020. However, the Court must once begin holding jury trials.

Please be advised that your health and safety are of the utmost concern to the Tribal Court. We have and are taking your safety into consideration when planning these jury trials.

We have worked with members of the Incident Command in assessing our space. Prospective jurors will be practicing social distancing both in the courtroom and while waiting for selection. The Court has three (3) rooms for prospective jurors to use while awaiting selection.

We will and have been scheduling 'deep cleaning' of this facility and will continue to do so throughout this pandemic.

Face masks are required to be worn by all. Please bring your face mask with you to court. If you forget or do not have one, a face mask will be provided to you. The judge will be able to make a ruling for a witness to testify without a mask on. Hand sanitizer will be available for all.

Once a jury panel is selected, social distancing will continue to be in effect. Only persons involved with the jury trial will be allowed in court due to social distancing requirements.

Your safety and health remain at the forefront. If you notice any conditions that need to be addressed, please let either the Clerk of Courts or presiding judge know of your concern(s).
