Effective September 28, 2020, the loop outside of the LEC building and Wilmer Peters Judicial Center will be off limits and going through a transformation. You will not be able to access this building through the front doors.

Please note that it is imperative that you make an appointment to gain access to this complex. Persons with appointments will be directed to the back door of the Wilmer Peters Judicial Center that is closest to Wolf River Drive. The door will not be open but will remain locked. Thus it is extremely important that you make an appointment with the department with whom you need to interact.
