Peters Judicial Center includes the Menominee Tribal Court, the Clerks Office, Probation Offices, Elections Office, and the Kakaeccec Office, as well as all public spaces and Judicial Offices and Court rooms. Each office manages confidential information while conducting day-to-day operations. It is imperative to respect and guard the space needed to conduct personal matters. Although visitors have always been expected to conduct themselves in a certain manner, it is necessary to inform all visitors of guidelines and rules of conduct.
